With this in mind, I want to challenge you to shoot the ball 10,000 times between June 1st and September 3rd. I realize that this will be a difficult feat to achieve and I want to state that this is in no way a mandatory requirement. Instead, this program is designed to recognize those players that go above and beyond in their efforts to improve. Those that successfully complete the program will receive a Shooting-shirt that commemorates the accomplishment and will be recognized at our pre-season "Meet the Team" meeting and our post season banquet. Keep in mind that this is not an opportunity that is exclusive to our high school players, but is instead open to all Future Firebirds as well.

The requirements for completion are simple. Keep a notebook or binder that logs your daily practice. Note the dates, times and locations of all of your workouts as well as some detail on the types of shots that you practiced. For the best possible improvement, it is essential that you record your numbers of makes vs. misses so that you may track improvement accordingly. At the end of each entry, include your signature to mark that your documentation is honest and reflects your integrity and character. Your notebook or binder can be turned in to me at school on September 4th. I encourage you to lean on each other for motivation and encouragement towards meeting this goal together and I hope that this will continue to be an annual tradition in our program.

We had a great year for The Bombers Club in 2017. We had 18 players earn the honor last summer which brings our total over 5 years to almost 70 players that have achieved this impressive feat. You will find their names and records on the back of this page. I am very grateful for the commitment of those young men that have helped to elevate this tradition over the past year and I look forward to including your name in next year's letter.
