PARENT/PLAYER RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT

The following is a brief summary of the responsibilities that the GWOC and the head coach would like each player and parent to review.

PLAYER ATTITUDE / BEHAVIOR / GRADES:

- Players should maintain a positive attitude at all times.
- Players are to be respectful toward coaches, teammates, opposing teams, referees, and fans.
- Profanity, rude behavior, or inappropriate talk will not be tolerated.
- Players are not to argue or talk negatively with referees.
- Schoolwork is the priority. Players should maintain good grades and positive conduct in school.

Players can be removed from the league for violent and/or repeated violations of the rules.

PARENT EXPECTATIONS:

The GWOC Youth Basketball Association and its programs ask the parents and spectators to refrain from inappropriate conduct from the stands. It makes it very difficult on everyone involved. We do encourage parents to cheer positively for their team. Parents are asked to refrain from making negative comments concerning your players and coaches, opposing players, opposing coaches, opposing program personnel, and referees. If a problem arises, the program director and/or the head coach of that program will address the issue with the individual involved. Parents who choose not to follow the above guidelines could lose their privilege of attending games.

END OF YEAR TOURNAMENTS:

At the end of the regular season, the teams will play in the GWOC Tournament. Each program will have the opportunity to host a grade level tournament depending on their facilities and ability to properly staff the tournament. The expectations of players, parents, and coaches will be the same for the tournament as it is for the regular season.
